



CURRICULUM

TO NURTURE THE BODY MIND AND SPIRIT

While implementation and execution of the CBSE curriculum our outstanding innovations offer exciting, rich, varied and broad course of study, which help to develop students' skills for all aspects of learning. We work hard to create a sense of excitement and an enthusiasm for lifelong learning and to ensure that all students achieve not only in their exams but in life-skills also.

o LINGUISTIC ARENA: ENGLISH, HINDI, SANSKRIT and PUNJABI

Our language curriculum consists of four linked elements: reading, writing, listening, and speaking. As the children enter primary school with different skill levels, they are all supported and challenged to develop their skills fully. We employ a multi-faceted approach to all areas of language arts. To help them to become good readers and writers, the students are immersed in literature. Listening to books read aloud, discussing the stories, and responding to them orally or in a written format are

essential elements of our program. A phonics program supports the acquisition of reading and writing skills and sound-symbol relationships are taught in a relevant and meaningful way.

o PLAYING WITH NUMBERS:

Under the curricular guidelines of CBSE, we use a program which is designed to help all children understand the fundamental ideas of number and operations, data handling, algebra and basic trigonometry. We supplement the program with our own materials when necessary to reinforce students' understanding of important mathematical concepts and skills.

o CHARACTER BUILDING:

While giving the value education we aim at instilling the core values of honesty, patience, kindness, responsibility, empathy, loyalty, patriotism respect for living things, cooperation, and humility among other values.





SOUND MIND IN SOUND BODY:

Our EVS classes focus on the development of basic scientific process skills by guiding and appropriate the natural surjective within each

basic scientific process skills by guiding and encouraging the natural curiosity within each student. The students explore the world by making observations, asking questions, hypothesizing, and drawing conclusions through a syllabus which cover a wide variety of topics. The students are exposed to scientific language through class discussions and reading science-based age appropriate literature.

o NURTURING CREATIVITY:

At AGS, art education seeks to encourage experience and expression. Students have opportunities to balance structure and establish the safe and appropriate use of materials and basic techniques in an atmosphere that encourages individual ideas and interests. Drawing and music enhances the creative abilities of children.

The physical education program emphasizes fundamental locomotors, stability, and manipulative movements (running, skipping, throwing, catching, etc.) for primary classes. The senior students are given training in Badminton, basketball, skating, Lawn-tennis, table —tennis, javelin throw, discus throw, shot put, long jump, high-jump, chess etc. to prepare them for state level and national level competitions. The teachers strive to develop personal athletic growth and a team spirit rather than focus only on competition.

o e-LEARNING:

ARBOUR GROVE School computer program is integrated with the regular classroom curriculum. In addition to the knowledge of basic computer skills class-wise learning program is adopted.

TO LEAD & CO-OPERATE

The school has established a House system starting from Grade III to encourage the learners to work in unison, co - operation and have healthy competition. We have four Houses in the School:

- Tendulkar House (Red)
- · Einstein House (Yellow)
- · Teresa House (Blue)
- Gandhi House (Green)

Each House is headed by one boy and one girl known as the "House Captain" and they are assisted by, "House Prefect". A member of the staff is "House Warden" who is assisted by several other teachers, "House Tutors". Each House is on duty for one week in a month. Points are awarded to the House on the basis of display boards, maintenance of discipline, presentation of news and thoughts etc. A number of Inter - House Competitions are organized throughout the year. At the end of the year the House gaining the highest number of points is declared the winner and bags the prestigious Inter - House Rolling Trophy.

This division of houses is done to encourage team spirit through healthy competitions. By working in teams and individually, students practice and refine their social skills such as cooperation and communication, caring and sharing, while learning to value their individual talents and interests.

Counselling Services:

At ARBOUR GROVE, a child's emotional well-being is as critical to his success as his academic preparation. A teacher is assigned to each House as an advisor to offer support to students in a variety of ways. Students of the same House meet regularly in small advisory groups to offer mutual support and to discuss a wide variety of topics in an intimate setting.

o Special-Care Program:

This Program offers additional educational support for students in all Houses. A wide range of students benefit through this program; some have learning difficulties, others need more time and practice to develop underlying learning skills. The program focuses on the process rather than the content of learning.





ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A basic admission test will be conducted on specified date for eligibility of that particular class. Only those candidates who clear the written test will be called for an interview. The admission would be confirmed only after the final interview.

Only meritorious students will be considered for mid-term admission on grounds of transfer or change of school.

The school reserves the right to admit a student in the appropriate class after examining the student. Even after the admission is granted the student can either be adjusted in a lower or higher class, which ever the case may be, depending upon the student's ability at the discretion of the authorities.

Admission is strictly subject to fulfilling of all conditions and submission of requisite documents.

VISION STATEMENT


Our vision is to develop a natural, holistic, student-centered learning environment that empowers and inspires our students to be creative, innovative, green leaders.
